As a part of your graduate application to the program in speech-language pathology at Florida State University you are to write a personal statement/letter of intent. This letter will be no more than 8,000 characters long. Your letter should address the following questions. You can and should address other aspects of your professional and clinical development.

- 1) Describe how you became interested in studying speech-language pathology.
- 2) Describe what you have done to gain understanding and/or experience in the clinical practice of speech-language pathology, e.g. extracurricular activity, coursework, service learning, employment.
- 3) Discuss the aspects of the graduate program in speech-language pathology at Florida State University that make it a good match for your learning and professional goals.
- 4) Describe your qualities/attributes/qualifications that make you a good prospect as a graduate student in speech-language pathology at Florida State University and after graduation as a practicing speech-language pathologist.
